"A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE HEAD OF THE PROCURING ENTITY (HOPE) TO AWARD PURCHASE REQUEST NO. 24-3633 TO METER KING, INC. AS THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BIDDER FOR THE JOB ORDER: FURNISHING LABOR AND MATERIALS OF THREE (3) PHASE ELECTRICAL TRANSMISSION LINES AND THREE (3) UNITS OF 25KVA DISTRIBUTION UNDER BID NO. B-24-0220 REBID."

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Davao de Oro advertised the Invitation to Bid for the procurement of JOB ORDER: FURNISHING LABOR AND MATERIALS OF THREE (3) PHASE ELECTRICAL TRANSMISSION LINES AND THREE (3) UNITS OF 25KVA DISTRIBUTION under Bid No. B-24-0220 REBID POSTED on its website, the PHILGEPS, and at a conspicuous place within the premises of the Provincial Government of Davao de Oro continuously for seven (7) calendar days;

WHEREAS, the BAC pursuant to Section 30 of R.A. 9184 used the nondiscretionary pass/fail criteria and conducted public bidding on October 1, 2024, that were attended by the following bidders/suppliers, to wit;

WHEREAS, having both METER KING, INC. and C-8 CONSTRUCTION SERVICES offered the same bid quotation, the Committee declared that both bidders shall undergo post-qualification by the Technical Working Group for being the Lowest bidder and to determine whether the bidder complies with and is responsive to all requirements and conditions as specified in the bidding documents;

WHEREAS, given the complexity of the goods to be procured, the Technical Working Group (TWG) will conduct a thorough technical evaluation and verification process to assess the Lowest Calculated Bidder's (LCB) qualifications and technical documentation as mandated under Section 34.8, the TWG is required to complete the post-qualification within 12 calendar days but may extend up to 30 days for technical evaluations;

WHEREAS, as the result of the post-qualification process, both METER KING, INC. and C-8 CONSTRUCTION SERVICES were considered as Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the GPPB Circular No. 06-2005, the committee decided to break the tie using the toss-the-coin method in the presence of representatives from METER KING, INC. and C-8 CONSTRUCTION SERVICES resulting to luck favoring METER KING, INC.;

WHEREAS, the detailed evaluation of bids conducted on October 9, 2024, resulted in the following;

WHEREAS, if the BAC determines that the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid passes all the criteria for post-qualification, it shall declare the said bidder as LCRB and recommend to the HoPE the award of contract to the said bidder at its submitted bid price or its calculated bid price, whichever is lower, as stated in Section 34.4 of the IRR;

WHEREAS, the BAC further agreed that in the event that the bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder (LCRB) fails, refuses, or is unable to submit the necessary documents as stated in Section 37 of this IRR, the BAC will disqualify said bidder and proceed to complete the post-qualification process with the bidder having the second Lowest Calculated Bid/Highest Rated Bid. If no bidder successfully passes the post-qualification stage, the BAC will declare the bidding as a failure and arrange for a re-bidding with re-advertisement. If another bidding failure occurs even after the contract's re-bidding, the Procuring Entity is permitted to engage in a negotiated procurement.

WHEREAS, upon careful examination, validation, and verification of all the eligibility, technical, and financial requirements submitted by the bidder as a Lowest Calculated Bid, its bid has been found to be responsive.

NOW THEREFORE, We, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVED**:

a) To recommend to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE) to award Purchase Request No. 24-3633 to METER KING, INC. as a Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder for the procurement of JOB ORDER: FURNISHING LABOR AND MATERIALS OF THREE (3) PHASE ELECTRICAL TRANSMISSION LINES AND THREE (3) UNITS OF 25KVA DISTRIBUTION under Bid No. B-24-0220 REBID.
