## **RESOLUTION NUMBER RO-03.11.12 SERIES OF 2025**

"A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE HEAD OF THE PROCURING ENTITY (HOPE) TO AWARD PURCHASE REQUEST NO. 25-2140 UNIFORM SUPPLIES FOR THE USE OF DAVRAA MEET 2025 WITH A CONTRACT AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED PESOS (₱178,200.00) TO MJM ART & TAILOR WHO QUOTED WITHIN THE APPROVED BUDGET OF THE CONTRACT FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF GOODS THROUGH REPEAT ORDER UNDER SECTION 51 OF 2016 REVISED IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR) OF R.A. 9184;"

WHEREAS, as a result of the increase in participating athletes for DAVRAA 2025, the end-users determined the necessity to replenish uniform supplies to adequately accommodate the additional participants;

WHEREAS, recognizing the need for an additional quantity of uniform supplies, the end-users have submitted a request to the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) under Purchase Request No. 25-2140 through a Repeat Order, in accordance with Section 51 of R.A. 9184 and its IRR.

WHEREAS, after a thorough evaluation of the Purchase Request, the Technical Working Group (TWG) determined that the unit price of the re-order remained consistent with the original contract previously awarded and did not exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the quantity of the item in the original contract, thereby leading the TWG to recommend that the aforementioned purchase request be procured through a Repeat Order in accordance with Section 51 of R.A. 9184;



WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee approved the recommendation of the Technical Working Group (TWG), that the procurement of goods covered by the abovementioned purchase request be done by way of a Repeat Order pursuant to Section 51 of Revised 2016 Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee previously conducted a Public Bidding for the procurement of the abovementioned items under Bid No. B-25-0001, which was awarded to MJM Arts & Tailor on January 28, 2025 as per figures in the table below under the Original Contract as follows;

WHEREAS, the repeat order is in accordance with the following conditions under Section 51 of R.A. 9184 and its IRR;

- The unit price of the repeat order must be the same as or lowest than those in the original contract: Provided, such price is still the most advantageous to the GoP after price verification:
- b. The repeat order will not result in the splitting of contracts, requisitions, or purchase order, as provided for in Section 54.1 of the IRR;
- Except in cases duly approved by the GPPB, the repeat order shall be availed of only within six (6) months from the date of the Notice to Proceed arising from the original contact: Provided, that there has been a partial delivery, inspection, and acceptance of the goods within the same 6-month period; and
- The repeat order shall not exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the quantity of each item in the original contract. In order not to exceed the 25% threshold, the goods under the original contract must:
  - i. Quantifiable
  - ii. Divisible; and
  - iii. Consisting of at least four (4) units per item.

WHEREAS, after careful evaluation, the Bids and Awards Committee finds that the conditions set forth under Section 51 of R.A. 9184 have been met, and the procurement of uniform supplies through Repeat Order is justifiable.

WHEREFORE, on motion of Dr. Rolando S. Simene and duly seconded by Atty. Maria Cor Reyna M. Mutoc; it was,

RESOLVED, the Bids and Awards Committee, RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED to recommend to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE) to award Purchase Request No. 25-2140 Uniform Supplies for the use of DAVRAA Meet 2025 with a contract amount of One Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (\$178,200.00) to MJM Art & Tailor who quoted within the approved budget of the contract for the procurement of goods through Repeat Order under Section 51 of 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of R.A. 9184.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copies of this resolution be forwarded to concerned offices for information, guidance, and appropriate action.
